Eligibility criteria for the WCP 2017 Young Fellowship Programme

- under the age of 40 at the opening date of the congress (8 October 2017)
- in full time training and and/or practicing for less than 7 years (residents and those candidates within 7 years from specialisation)

How to apply for the Young Fellowship Programme

Step 1: Create a new account

Step 2: Fill in the application form for the Young Fellowship Programme.

Step 3: Please have the following documents ready:

- a letter of recommendation from your supervisor or head of department which proofs the resident status and a curriculum vitae with your application.

- a copy of your passport or another document that proves your age, e.g. a birth certificate. - your CV

Step 4: Submit an abstract to the congress via "MY CONGRESS" until 27 March 2017.

Step 5: After the deadline, every application will be reviewed carefully. You will be informed about the outcome by the end of April 2017.
